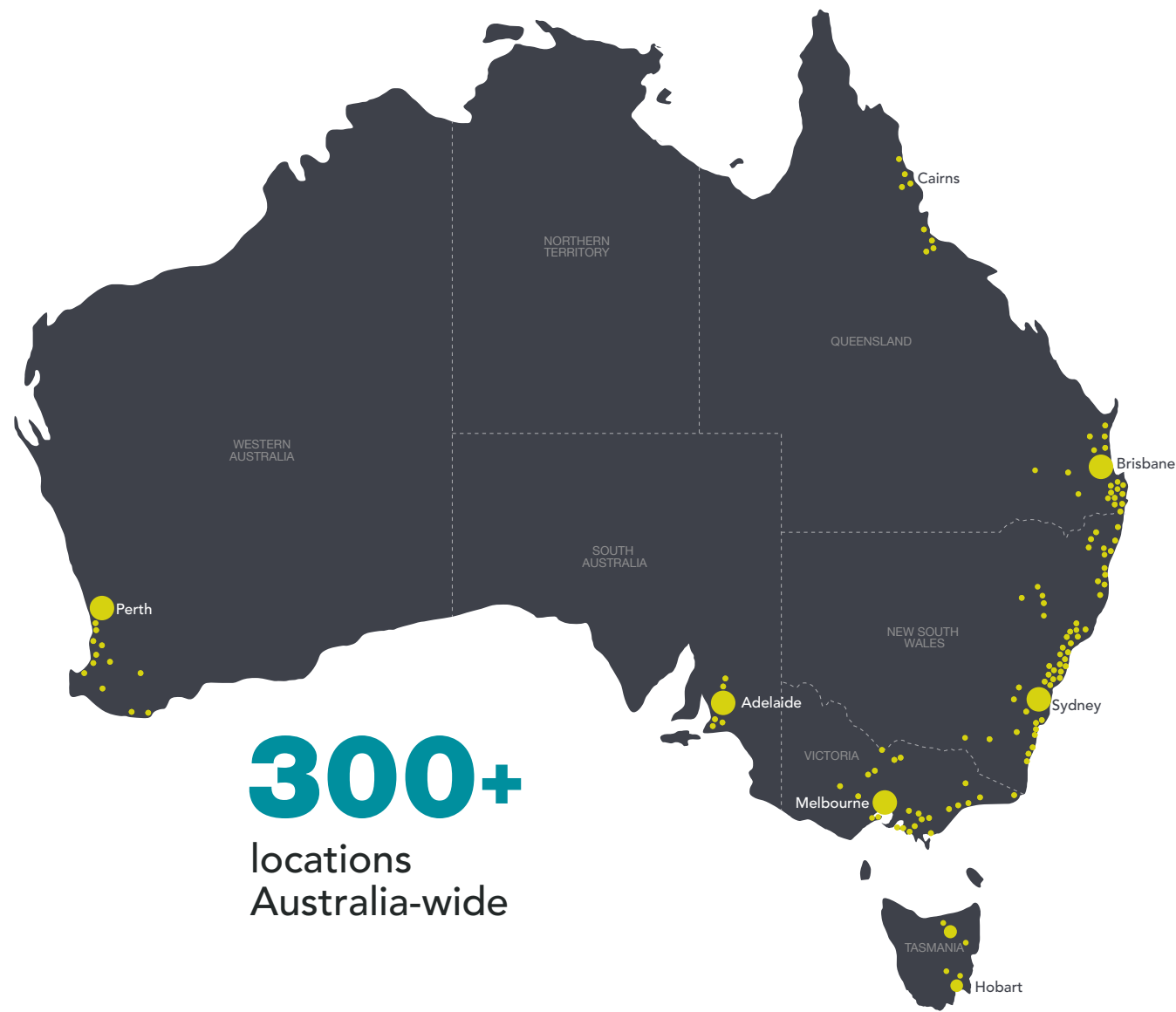

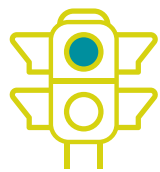

Spotlight on a key employer partner

In 2018, the Department of Jobs & Small Business approached atWork Australia to engage with VenuesLive to implement an internship model for unemployed youth within the hospitality sector.

The resulting pilot program is the Stadium Youth (STAY) Program. The aim is to train and prepare participants to commence the Youth Jobs PaTH internship with VenuesLive (at Optus Stadium) in Perth, which leads to employment for successful participants. Young job seekers complete a three-week Employability Skills Training (EST) program under the direction of Skill Hire to gain a comprehensive introduction into working in the hospitality industry.
